Please remember that we have transitioned to a 10-point grading scale for this academic year.

Our prior year (2015-2016) was based on a 7-point grading scale.

The 1st-2nd grades reflect the following categories and percentages for Language Arts, Math, Bible and Science - 10% for homework/classwork, 40% for quizzes and 50% for tests.

The 3rd-4th grades reflect the following categories and percentages for Language Arts and Math - 10% for homework/classwork, 40% for quizzes and 50% for tests. Bible, History and Science - 50% for homework/classwork and 50% for quizzes and tests.

The 5th-12th grades reflect the following categories and percentages - 20% for homework/classwork, 30% for quizzes and 50% for tests.
