Distribution and Returning School Issued Mobile Device

Distribution of DCS Issued Mobile Device

- A DCS Issued Mobile Device will be distributed for student use. Students will use a DCS Issued Mobile Device and gain access to the DCS student network.
- Parents and students must sign and return the DCS Technology Signature Page which outlines school policies for the Issued Mobile Device Agreement and Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) before the school can issue a Mobile Device or grant student access to the DCS network.

Returning DCS Issued Mobile Device

- Failure to return items may result in the Mobile Device being reported stolen and police involvement to recover the device; the student may be subject to criminal prosecution or civil liability. The student will also be required to pay the full replacement cost for a new DCS Issued Mobile Device and accessories.

Identification of DCS Issued Mobile Device

- Each student's Mobile Device will be labeled in the manner specified by the school. The Mobile Device can be identified by Serial Number and Dillon Christian School inventory label. The school inventory label and any manufacturer's label should not be removed from the device. The school will assess charges for removal or defacement of these labels and barcodes.

Mobile Device Agreement and Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

Computer Loan Agreement One Google Chromebook and Charger are being loaned to the Student/Borrower and are in good working order. It is the Student/Borrower's responsibility to care for the equipment and ensure that it is retained in a safe environment. This equipment is, and at all time remains, the property of Dillon Christian School and is herewith lent to the Student/Borrower for educational

purposes only for the academic school year. Students shall have no expectation of privacy with respect to the Chromebooks provided by the school or any materials therein. The school may inspect the Chromebooks and review materials therein at any time with or without notice. Student/Borrower may not deface or destroy this property in any way. Inappropriate use of the machine may result in the Student/Borrower losing his/her right to use this computer. The equipment will be returned to the school when requested by Dillon Christian School, or sooner, if the Student/Borrower withdraws from Dillon Christian School prior to the end of the school year. The school Property may be used by Student/Borrower only for non-commercial purposes, in accordance with the school's policies and rules, the school's Code of Conduct, as well as, local, state, and federal statutes. Please review the assurances of both the parents and students. Student/Borrower may not install or use any software other than software owned or approved by the school and made available to Student/Borrower in accordance with this Receipt and Agreement. One user account with specific privileges and capabilities has been set up on the Google Chromebook for the exclusive use of the Student/Borrower to which it has been assigned. The Student/Borrower agrees to make no attempts to change or allow others to change the privileges and capabilities of this user account.

The Student/Borrower agrees to make no attempts to add, delete, access, or modify other user accounts on the Google Chromebook and on any school-owned computer. The Dillon Christian School network is provided for the academic use of all students and staff. The Student/Borrower agrees to take no action that would interfere with the efficient, academic use of the network. Identification and inventory labels/tags have been placed on the Google Chromebook. These labels/ tags are not to be removed or modified. If they become damaged or missing, contact tech support for replacements. Additional stickers, labels, tags, or markings are not to be added to the Google Chromebook. A Google Apps for Education account is available for each Student/Borrower to use for appropriate academic communication with other students and staff members. The law allows the school to obtain reimbursement from, or on behalf of, students for any damage to, loss of, or failure to return school property. The full cost of the Google Chromebook is \$350.00 (which includes the replacement cost and three year warranty). Student/ Borrower acknowledges and agrees that his/her use of the school Property is a privilege and that by Student/Borrower's agreement to the terms hereof, Student/Borrower acknowledges his/her responsibility to protect and safeguard the school Property and to return the same in good condition and repair upon request by Dillon Christian School. Students and parents/guardians must immediately report any damage to or loss of the Chromebook or accessories to the DCS School Office. In the event of damage to the Chromebook or accessories which is not covered by the warranty, the student and parents/guardians will be billed for the cost of repair or replacement of the Chromebook or accessories according to the schedule on the following page.

In the event the Chromebook or accessories are lost, stolen, or otherwise not returned to the school, the student and parents/guardians will be billed a fine for the full cost of replacement of the Chromebooks or accessories. Students who violate any of the provisions of this computer loan agreement or any other school rules or policies applicable to the use of the Chromebooks will be subject to disciplinary action.

Parent Responsibilities

Your son/daughter has been issued a Google Chromebook computer to improve and personalize his/ her education this year. It is essential that the following guidelines be followed to ensure the safe, efficient, and ethical operation of this computer.

- I will supervise my son's daughter's use of the Google Chromebook at home.
- I will discuss our family's values and expectations regarding the use of the Internet at home and will supervise my son's/ daughter's use of the Internet.
- I will not attempt to repair the Google Chromebook.
- I will report to the school any problems with the Chromebook.
- I will make sure that my son/daughter recharges the Google Chromebook battery nightly. I will make sure my son/daughter brings the Google Chromebook to school every day.
- I understand that if my son/daughter comes to school without his/her computer, I may be called to bring it to school.
- I agree to make sure that the Google Chromebook is returned to the school when requested and upon my son's/daughter's withdrawal from Dillon Christian School.

Student Responsibilities

Your Google Chromebook is an important learning tool and is for educational purposes only. In order to take your Google Chromebook home each day, you must be willing to accept the following responsibilities.

- When using the Google Chromebook at home, at school, and anywhere else I may take it, I will follow the policies of the Dillon Christian School - especially the Student Code of Conduct
- I will abide by all local, state, and federal laws.
- I will treat the Google Chromebook with care by not dropping it, getting it wet, leaving it outdoors, or using it with food or drink nearby.
- My Google Chromebook is my responsibility and will stay in my possession at all times.
- I will not modify any software on the Google Chromebook.
- I will honor my family's values when using the Google Chromebook.
- I will not release personal information to strangers when using the Google Chromebook.
- I will bring the Google Chromebook to school every day.
- I will keep all accounts and passwords assigned to me secure, and will not share these with any other students.
- I will clean my Google Chromebook using only the method taught by the school.
- I will recharge the Google Chromebook battery each night.
- I will return the Google Chromebook when requested and upon my withdrawal from Dillon Christian School.
- I will place the Google Chromebook in its protective case when not in use and when it is being moved.

Mobile Device Acceptance Form

- I understand that all mobile technology devices, equipment, and/or accessories the school has provided to me are the property of Dillon Christian School.
 - I agree to all of the terms in the Mobile Technology Policy and in the Dillon Christian School's other policies relating to technology use.
 - I will return the equipment to the school in the same condition in which it was provided.
 - I will not install any malicious or damaging software or change the configuration of the equipment in any way.
 - I will not allow any other individuals to use the device and/or related equipment and accessories provided by the school.
 - I understand that any violation of the terms and conditions contained in the school's technology policies may result in the restriction and/or termination of my use of school mobile technology devices, equipment, and/or accessories, as well as possible disciplinary action, up to and including termination.
 - I understand that I am personally and financially responsible for any damage to the mobile device and/or its related equipment and accessories user negligence as deemed by the school's administration and Dillon Christian School's Technology Department.
 - I understand that I am personally and financially responsible for the loss or theft of any such device and/or related equipment and accessories.
 - I understand that I have no expectation of privacy in my use of DCS-owned devices and that the school may, at any time it deems necessary, examine all materials contained on such computers.
